

## **Tour of Institutions by the President of the Council of Ministers of OHADA**

**(Porto Novo, Abidjan and Yaoundé, 28 May-2 June 2016)**

As part of his tour in the OHADA Institutions, **His Excellency Pierre MABIALA**, Minister of Justice, human rights and promotion of indigenous rights of the Republic of Congo and current President of the Council of Ministers of OHADA, toured the institutions of OHADA from May 28 to June 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2016. Accompanied by **Professor Dorothé Cossi SOSSA**, Permanent Secretary of OHADA, the President of the Council of Ministers visited in turn the Higher Regional School of Magistracy (ERSUMA) in Porto-Novo, the Common Court of Justice and Arbitration (CCJA) in Abidjan and the Permanent Secretariat in Yaounde.

Besides visiting the premises of these Institutions, **H.E. Pierre MABIALA** held talks with Heads of the various Institutions and with staff; these exchanges enabled to review the various concerns and to make suggestions to optimize the functioning of Institutions. He also paid a courtesy visit to his Government counterparts from Benin, Côte d'Ivoire and Cameroon.

This tour is within the framework of the traditional visit of the President of the Council of Ministers in OHADA Institutions. It comes shortly before the first annual session of the Council of Ministers scheduled from 16 to 17 June 2016 in Brazzaville (Congo). / -
